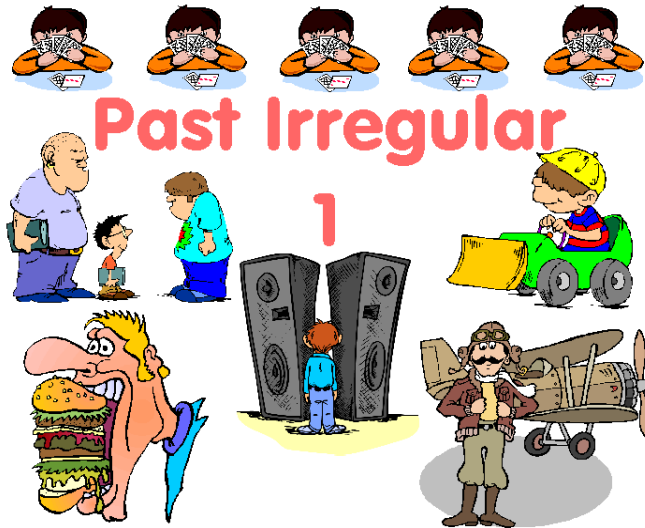


Past Irregular

I flew a jet fighter.

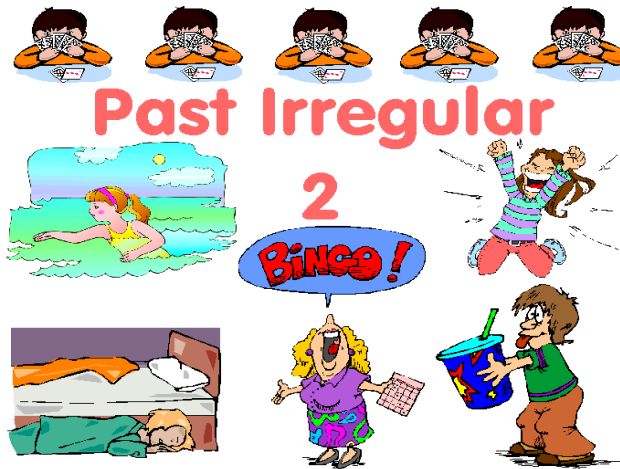
What did you draw yesterday?

Past Irregular

1. Shuffle & deal 7 cards each, place pack face down. Players lay any pairs face up saying for example "He got a big dog. He got a new bicycle."

2. 1st player lays a card and says "I lost my job. Jun, what did you lose today?" "I lost my head. Here you are." Then as in '1.'

3. Or "I didn't lose anything. Take a card."

Note: the "lost" card stays on the table, then play passes to the next player.

3. When a player has no more cards in his hand, then play continues until it's his turn again. The game now ends. To extend the game the finished player can take a bonus card from the pack when it's his turn again. Cards on the table can be counted as points and cards in your hand as negative points should it be so desired.

Note: packs can be mixed easily.

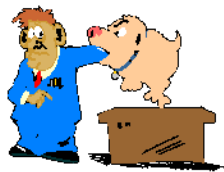
