

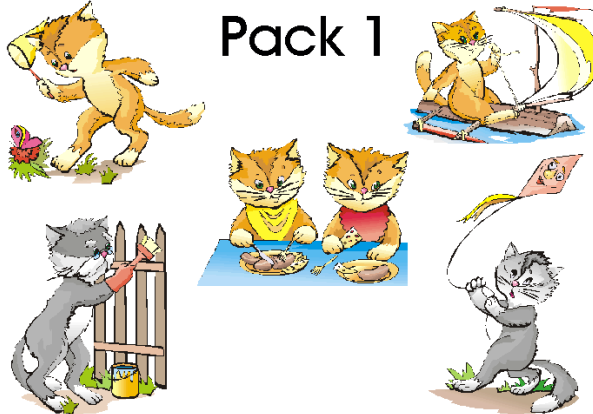
Present Continuous Packs 1-3

Present Continuous

1. Shuffle & deal 7 cards each, place pack face down. Players lay any pairs face up saying for example "She's writing a story. He's writing a letter."
2. 1st player lays a card and says "I'm flying a kite. Jun, what are you flying?" "I'm flying a plane. Here you are." Then as in '1.'
3. Or "I'm not flying anything. Take a card." Note: the kite card stays on the table, then play passes to the next player.
3. When a player has no more cards in her hand, then play continues until it's her turn again. The game now ends. To extend the game the finished player can take a bonus card from the pack when it's her turn again. Cards on the table can be counted as points and cards in your hand as negative points should it be so desired.
