There is some concrete in the truck.

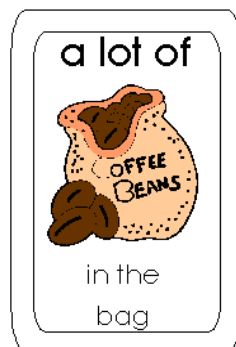
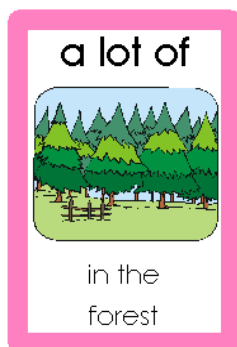
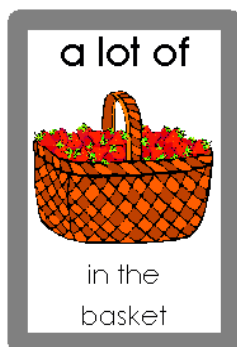
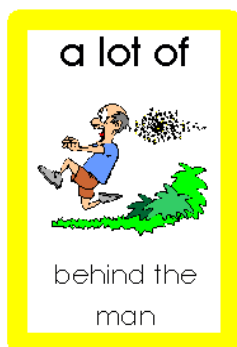
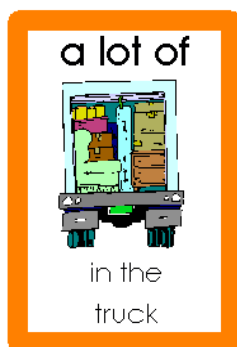
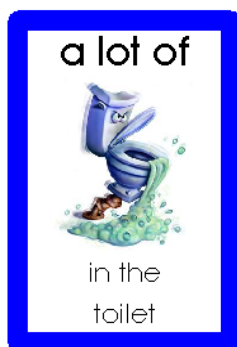
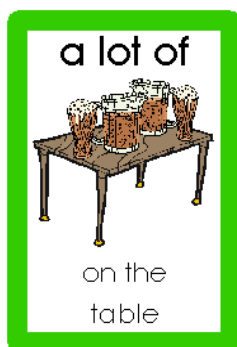
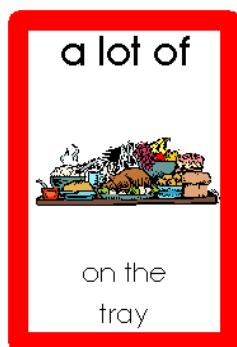

### QUANTIFYING SWITCHIT RULES

1. Deal 7 cards to each player.
2. Place the pack facedown and turn over the top card.
3. The 1st player plays a card, which matches the color or key word of the card in play, and makes a "There is" or "There are" statement.
4. A special switchit card changes the color or key word of the card to be played.
5. When a player cannot play, then a card from the pack.
6. The object of the game is to get rid of all your cards.
7. Remove pack after a winner is found and continue playing.
